Once more Paul summarises: “Believe me! The men who want to mix you up only want to boast later on that they have managed to change your mind (vv11-13)! I’m not proud of anything, apart from the cross of the Lord Jesus!”

Christians know that they owe everything to the work of the Lord Jesus on the cross. But for the world, the cross is something to be despised. This leads to a sharp separation between those who are saved by the cross and the world (v14). – Do you know something of this?

At the end of his letter Paul expresses his good wishes for those who follow his words (v16).
