

God remembers, pleads and warns



Jeremiah addresses the people in Jerusalem with his first message. The Lord has not forgotten how Israel followed Him at the beginning (vv1-3). God asks the Jews what He has done wrong that they have turned away from Him and are serving idols instead (vv4-8) Then God analyses the condition of the people (vv9-13). Judah doesn't notice their bad condition (vv14-19); they even deny their guilt (v23).

They haven't got time for God, but He is useful to be called on in an emergency (v27b). Displaying this attitude, the people won't escape punishment.

5. How many idols of wood and stone have they made? Clue: read again verses 26-28!

6. Why will God's judgment meet them (v35)?

Baal was the name of a heathen idol. People believed that the growth of crops and herds was dependent on this idol. He is often mentioned in the Bible in connection with the female goddess Asherah.
