## Babylon's got it wrong!



Babylon has been the "rod of correction" in the hand of God in order to punish his apostate people. But from this, the Babylonians have drawn the wrong conclusion (see question 138).

It is predicted for Babylon too that God will judge them for their sins. A nation (v3), even an "assembly of great nations" (v9) will come from the north (viewed from the Middle East) against Babylon and will "make it desolate".

It all sounds very much up to date if you remember that the old city of Babylon is situated in today's Iraq.

After that the Lord will bring His people into their land again and will forgive them their sins (vv19-20).

139. With what does the Lord compare His people (vv6+17-10)?

A "standard" is the name for the "flags" of certain military entities.

It was used for the standards or banners of the four divisions of Israel, consisting of three tribes each.



If the Lord Jesus is your Saviour, it also applies to you: If your sins are searched for, they will not be found any more (v20)!

138. The nations thought that they could do with the Jews what they wanted because they had sinned against God. - But this was a wrong conclusion. (That God used them as a means for discipline is a different matter.) 139. With a lost herd of sheep who are led astray by their own shepherds and with a lost sheen scared off hv a lion. - The reason was therefore "inside" (shepherds) as well as "outside" (lion).
