## **Elite units**




You get elite units for special tasks. Have you ever dreamed of being trained in such a group? You probably know that the candidates are chosen according to strict criteria.

How is it with the Lord Jesus? How does *He* choose His "fighters"? He prays the whole night long on His own on a mountain (v12). Only then He chooses the twelve apostles (vv13-16). – How much more necessary is it for you as a young Christian to pray when you are confronted with small or big decisions, like: What job? What training? What marriage partner? Take much time to speak about this with your Lord!

May people are again waiting for the Lord Jesus at easy to reach spots (vv17-18). Because He is the Son of God, "power goes out from Him" (v19).
