## The dream of the great image



Because God has revealed it to him, Daniel can now tell Nebuchadnezzar his dream and at the same time explain it. The dream affects Nebuchadnezzar personally. At the same time, God permits a glimpse into the future, up till the end of the Millennium.

Let's accompany Daniel on his journey into the history of the Middle East, which for him is, mainly, future:

- Head: Babylon. Having only just become king, Nebuchadnezzar hears already about his end.
- Chest and arms: Medo-Persia. This will be Babylon's successor around 70 years later.
- Belly and thighs: Greece. Alexander the Great will subdue the whole world as it was known to the Chaldeans.
- Legs and feet: Roman Empire. It will conquer Greece, will later weaken and separate into Eastern and Western empires.
- The Stone: Christ. During His millennial reign He will destroy all human kingdoms – especially the Roman Empire, which will have been revived for a short time.

Of the four world empires, which are mentioned more than once in the book form of Daniel, the second one is the Medo Persian Empire. It started when the Persians (under Cyrus in 550BC) broke the traditional superiority of the Medes and amalgamated them into their kingdom; together they then subjected the New-Babylonian Empire in 539BC.
