Daniel's dream of the ram and the goat




Two years later, Daniel dreams again of animals. This time there are only two, a ram and a goat. First, there is the ram with two horns, the strongest animal around. Along comes a male goat, running without touching the ground, having one great horn, and conquers him. The great horn of the male goat breaks, and four horns come up. One of them is rather special, it grows great against Israel, takes away the permanent sacrifice, throws the truth to the ground and in all this is very successful.

Tomorrow you will read the interpretation of the dream. So far: The ram is the same as the bear of the previous dream, the male goat is the leopard.

The ram has two great horns of different size, because the empire consists of Medes and Persians, and the Persian people are more influential than the (older) Medes; for the same reason the bear rises up on one side (the Persian). 34.
