

## **Eternity**



In these verses, God shows the author John in a vision what it will be like when God has finally reached His goal. John sees a new heaven and a new earth. Everything that could remind of sin – also everything belonging to the first creation – has passed away. "Behold, I make all things new."

Two groups of people are mentioned:

- "the tabernacle (tent) of God" (v3) this is the church consisting of all people who have believed in Jesus in the time in which we live –
- And "men", the believers of other times (see info text).

The place where all unbelievers are is also their final destination and cannot be changed any more – the lake of fire, hell (v8).

In the eternal state two "groups" of people should be distinguished:

- The people on the new earth, who are called the people of God (v3) – all believers who don't belong to the church.
- Those who live in the new heaven and are the tabernacle of God with men the believers of the church.
