“By whom also we
have access by faith
into this grace wherein
we stand, and rejoice
in hope of the glory of
God.”

“And not only so,
but we glory in
tribulations also:
knowing that
tribulation works
patience”

“And patience,
experience;
and experience,
hope:”

“And hope makes not
ashamed; because the
love of God is shed
abroad in our hearts by
the Holy Ghost which is
given unto us.”

“For when we were yet
without strength, in
due time Christ died
for the ungodly.”

“For scarcely for a
righteous man will one
die: yet perhaps for a
good man some would
even dare to die.”

“But God commends
his love toward us, in
that, while we were
yet sinners, Christ
died for us.”

“Much more then,
being now justified by
his blood, we shall be

through him.”

the reconciliation.”

4. Boast in tribulations

“... and we *glory*
[*boast*] in *tribulations*
also”
