




#### Exo 25:23

And thou shalt make a table of acacia-wood,


- 2 cubits the length thereof, and
- 1 cubit the breadth thereof, and
- 1 ½ cubits the height thereof.



#### Exo 25:24

And thou shalt overlay it with pure gold,


and make upon it a border of gold round about.



#### Exo 25:25

And thou shalt make for it a margin of a handbreadth round about,

and shalt make a border of gold for the margin thereof round about.




#### Exo 25:26

And thou shalt make for it 4 rings of gold,

and put the rings at the 4 corners that are on the 4 feet thereof.


#### Exo 25:27

Close to the margin shall the rings be, as receptacles of the staves to carry the table.



#### Exo 25:28

And thou shalt make the staves of acacia-wood, and overlay them with gold; and the table shall be carried upon them.






#### Exo 25:29

And thou shalt make the dishes thereof, and cups thereof, and goblets thereof, and bowls thereof, with which to pour out: of pure gold shalt thou make them.


### Some answers

Lev 24:5 And thou shalt take fine wheaten flour, and bake 12 cakes thereof; each cake shall be of 2 tenths.


Lev 24:6 And thou shalt set them in 2 rows, 6 in a row, upon the pure table before Jehovah.

Lev 24:7 And thou shalt put pure frankincense upon each row; and it shall be a bread of remembrance, an offering by fire to Jehovah. Lev 24:8 Every sabbath day he shall arrange it before Jehovah continually, on the part of the children of Israel: *it is* an everlasting covenant.

Lev 24:9 And it shall be Aaron's and his sons'; and they shall eat it in a holy place; for it is most holy unto him of Jehovah's offerings by fire: *it is* an everlasting statute.







### Transport


Num 4:7 And upon the table of shewbread they shall spread a cloth of blue; and put thereon the dishes, and the cups, and the bowls, and goblets of the drink-offering; and the continual bread shall be thereon.

Num 4:8 And they shall spread upon them a cloth of scarlet, and cover it with a covering of badgers' skin, and shall put its staves to it.



### Expressions

- showbread, or bread of face, it was set before the face of God, perfectly acceptable to Him.
- the continual bread (Num. 4:7) it was ever before God;
- hallowed bread (1 Sam 21:5) holiness connected with this presentation.
- bread of ordering (1 Chr. 9:32, marg.) and bread of setting forth, or presentation (Heb. 9:2, Gr.) presented before God.



### Meaning

- Christ is the table
- The table is the basis for the presentation of the people before God
- 12 breads the entire people
- 2 rows witness!
- Frankincense the acceptability of Christ
- Drink offering joy in the completed work of Christ



### Meaning

- Main thoughts:
  - God has His people before Him
  - Presentation of the unity of God's people
    - 12 stones (Josh 4:3-9; 1 Kings 18:31,32)
    - 1 Cor 10:17
  - Remembrance (1. Cor 11:25)
  - Weekly (Acts 26:7)
  - Protected / guarded (border plus crowns!)



### Just worship!

### The measurements (1)

- 2 cubits the length thereof, and
- 1 cubit the breadth thereof, and
- 1 ½ cubits the height thereof.

Where fractions are used, multiply by 2:

- 4 universality
- 2 communion
- 3 divine



### The measurements (1)

- The height: 1 ½ cubits
  This is the same as the height of:
- The mercy seat
- The grating of network of copper of the copper altar

#### Hence:

- God's righteous demands
- Are met by the sacrifice
- And this is the basis for communion!





#### The menorah (מְנוֹרָה,)

- symbol of the Jewish people
- national emblem of Israel

#### The Arch of Titus (Arco di Tito)

- a 1st-century AD arch,
- Via Sacra, Rome, SE of Roman Forum.
- constructed in c. 81 AD to commemorate the victory of Titus
- depicts the triumphal procession (71 AD)
- shows the menorah (candle-stick)
- It became a symbol of the Jewish diaspora.










#### Exo 26:35

- And thou shalt set the table outside the veil,
- and the lamp-stand opposite to the table on the side of the tabernacle southward;
- and thou shalt put the table on the north side.



Exo 25:31 And thou shalt make a lamp-stand of pure gold; of beaten work shall the lampstand be made: its base and its shaft, its cups, its knobs, and its flowers shall be of the same.




Exo 25:32 And 6 branches shall come out of the sides thereof—

3 branches of the lamp-stand out of one side thereof,

and 3 branches of the lamp-stand out of the other side thereof;




Exo 25:33 3 cups shaped like almonds in the one branch, a knob and a flower...




Exo 25:34

And in the lamp-stand 4 cups shaped like almonds, its knobs and its flowers;



#### Exo 25:35

- a knob under 2 branches of it, and again
- a knob under 2 branches of it, and again
- a knob under 2 branches of it, for the 6 branches that proceed out of the lamp-stand.



#### Exo 25:36

Their knobs and their branches shall be

- of itself—
- all of one beaten work
- of pure gold.



#### Exo 25:37

And thou shalt make the 7 lamps thereof,

- and they shall light the lamps thereof,
- that they may shine out before it;





Exo 25:38

and the snuffers ("tongs") thereof, and the snuff-trays (snuff-dishes) thereof, of pure gold.

- Tongs used to clean the lamps by taking away the deposits that gathered in the lamps and for dealing with the spent wicks.
- Snuff-dishes trays, firepans, or dishes
  - into which the deposits taken from the lamps were placed.
  - also used to carry the fire with which to light the lamps after they were cleaned.

Exo 25:39

Of a talent of pure gold shall they make it, with all these utensils.

1 talent = 26 kg


Gold: £/kg: 47,372

Value: £1.23m!



Exo 25:40

And see that thou make them according to their pattern, which hath been shewn to thee in the mountain.




- Candlestick Christ
  - He was thus the light of men, the light of the world, etc. (John 1:4; John 8:12.)
  - Never was the light of the Spirit obscured in Him....
  - But especially: Christ risen sent the Spirit (Jn 16:7)
- Gold essential deity




- Almonds resurrection (Num. 17:8; Jer. 1:11)
- Flowers / Knobs fruit of resurrection (Num. 17:8)
- Oil the Spirit (1. John 2:20)
- 7 fullness (Rev 3:1 and Isa 11:1)
  - To give us light
  - To help us appreciate the glory of Christ




- Children of Israel had to bring olive oil (Ex. 27:20)
- In the light, the candlestick was seen (Num 8:2).



- Aaron was to order the lamps:
  - the light of the Spirit, maintained by the priestly care & intercession of Christ.
- He alone could use "the snuffers thereof, and the snuff-dishes thereof,"
  - both made of pure gold (v. 38.)
  - Every ray of light that shines out below, is but the answer to His priestly work



- "Trimming the lamp did not imply that it had failed to give light;
- "the priest
  - would not let it reach that stage,
  - but removed the charred part of the wick in order that there might be a fresh portion for the oil to pass through unhindered and to supply fuel for the lamp" (S. R.).



- Aaron and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD (Ex. 27:21).
  - The lamp is for the night
  - All through the night of Israel's unbelief, the golden candlestick is to be ordered before the Lord.
  - The testimony to their true place is maintained by the intercession of Him whom they crucified.
  - Till He rise as sun of righteousness...
